ButterJAM recommends using the free software WinSCP (winscp.net) or FileZilla (filezilla-project.org) to FTP to your account. Feel free to use any software that you are comfortable in as long as it supports the File Transfer Protocol: SFTP. This guide will use screenshots from WinSCP but the settings will be similar.

Below are the basic settings you need to use. When you have filled it in with your credentials and the settings described below, "Login".

Basic Settings:

Substitute "mydomain.com" with your own domain name. Substitute "myusername" with your own username. Make sure that the File Protocol is set to "SFTP" or "SSH File Transfer Protocol" and the port number is set to "2222." All other settings are at your own discretion and not critical. Your FTP program may have a different interface but should have these basic settings and options.
